GAIL SIMMONS & CURTIS STONE STARS OF TOP CHEF DUELS

OK! Q&A

On *Top Chef's* newest spin-off, **Gail Simmons** and **Curtis Stone** must judge 18 of the franchise's most memorable contestants as they face off in a series of one-on-one challenges. Listen in as the stars dish on all things food-related.

What's the hardest part of judging?

Gail: Finding creative ways to talk about food. It's one thing to say something is delicious, but that doesn't tell the audience what it actually tastes like.

Curtis: It's tough, because I sympathize with my peers who are working under extreme conditions but I have to be critical and point out what they did right and what they did wrong.

Have you been shocked by the contestants' improvements?

Curtis: I have to single out **Art Smith**. Not that he did poorly on *Top Chef Masters*, but this time around he cooked some beautiful food.

Who is the toughest guest judge this season?

Gail: **Rob Zombie**. He's vegan and takes food very seriously. He would even poke holes in some of the things that I loved!

What are your favorite foods to cook at home?

Gail: I spend most of my time making baby food! My daughter is 8 months old, so it's simple puréed fruits and vegetables.

Curtis: We have a big garden, so it depends on what's growing. We try to cook organically, so it can be a chicken roasted over a wood fire with some carrots pulled from the garden that morning.

What is the biggest misconception about you?

Curtis: I'm seen as serious — and when you host a TV show the information is pretty serious — but I'm actually silly and relaxed.

Gail: That I'm the "tough judge." When the chefs get to know me, they say, "Oh, you're less intimidating than I thought!"

What would you have as your last meal?

Gail: Something decadent — like sea urchin pasta with chilies and a big, charred porterhouse with potatoes.

Curtis: I want to go out drinking red wine and eating foie gras and chocolate pudding.
